

Ein gweledigaeth yw cefnogi plant i ddatblygu'r medrau, sgiliau a'r wybodaeth angenrheidiol i fod yn aelodau gofalus a defnyddiol o'n cymdeithas gyfnewidiol, tu fewn i amgylchedd hapus a sefydlog ac annog dilyniant trwy gamau datblygiad plentyn i fod yn ddysgwyr gydol oes.

Our vision is to enable children to develop their abilities, skills and knowledge required to become caring and purposeful members of our ever changing community within a happy and stable environment, and to encourage continuity through the stages of their development to become life-long learners.

POLISI IAITH / LANGUAGE POLICY

Ysgol gyfrwng Gymraeg yw Ysgol Gymunedol Peniel ac felly Cymraeg yw prif iaith yr ysgol. Derbynnir plant y dosbarth derbyn eu haddysg o'r diwrnod cyntaf yn y Gymraeg. Cyflwynir Saesneg ym mlwyddyn 3 lle cynigir gwersi Saesneg a chyflwynir rhai gwersi trawsgwricwlaidd yn yr iaith Saesneg hefyd. Darperir gohebiaeth ddwyieithog i bawb. Mae gwefan yr ysgol yn ddwyieithog.

Peniel Community School is a Welsh medium school therefore Welsh is our primary language. Pupils as they start in the reception class receive all their education through the medium of Welsh. English is introduced formally at year 3 whereby pupils receive English lessons. Also some cross curricular lessons are taught through the medium of English. All correspondence, including the school's website are bilingual.

ANGHENION DYSGU YCHWANEGOL/ADDITIONAL LEARNING NEEDS

Mae polisi ADY yr ysgol yn un effeithiol ac eang ac yn un sy'n cyflawni gofynion y Cod Ymarfer. Mae 8 o ddisgyblion ar y gofrestr, ac rydym yn awyddus i glustnodi unrhyw anawsterau sydd gan y plant cyn gynted ag y bo modd, ac ymateb iddynt yn y ffordd mwyaf priodol. Ystyrir bod ymyrraeth gynnar yn angenrheidiol i sicrhau diwallu anawsterau ag anghenion y plentyn unigol. Mae Mrs Cath Thomas yn cyd-weithio â'r athrawon dosbarth a'r cynorthwywyr i sicrhau bod y sesiynau unigol a dderbynia'r plant yn cael eu hymestyn a'u hymarfer yn feunyddiol o fewn gweithgarwch y dosbarth. Mae gan bob disgybl broffil un tudalen, boed yn broffil pwt neu'n broffil estynedig gyda thargedau SMART.

Mrs Helen Davies sydd wedi ei enwi fel llywodraethwr cyswllt yn y maes.

We have a comprehensive ALN policy that meets the requirements of the Code of Practice. We have 8 pupils on the register, as we regard it essential that any difficulties or needs are addressed as soon as possible, early intervention is an essential part of ensuring that all pupils needs are met. Mrs Cath Thomas works with all the staff to develop a whole school approach in order that the individual sessions are developed and extended through classroom activities. All learners have a one page profile be it a mini profile or a one page profile plus with SMART Targets.

AMCANION A CHYNLLUN CYDRADDOLDEB AC ANABLEDD

Nid oes unrhyw ddisgyblion anabl ar y gofrestr ar hyn o bryd. Mae'r ysgol wedi'i hadeiladu yn bwrpasol ac yn addas ar gyfer unrhyw berson anabl. Ceir copi o gynllun ac amcanion cydraddoldeb yr ysgol ar y wefan.

There are no disabled pupils on the register at present. The school building is purposely built and is suitable for any disabled pupil/adult. A copy of the school's Equality plan is published on the website.

AMDDIFFYN PLANT / CHILD PROTECTION

Mae polisi Iechyd a Diogelwch yr ysgol a'r polisi Amddiffyn Plant yn adlewyrchu dyhead y Corff Llywodraethol i sicrhau safle diogel i'r disgyblion a'r staff fel ei gilydd. Pwysleisir i'r staff y dylid rhoi gwybod i'r Swyddog Iechyd a Diogelwch ac Amddiffyn Plant (Pennaeth) am unrhyw ddiffygion/peryglon a phryderon yn syth. Mae'r ddau bolisi ar gael i'w darllen.

The school's Health and Safety policy and the Child Protection policy reflect the wish of the Governing Body to provide a safe and secure environment for both pupils and staff. All members of staff are advised of their duty to report any deficiencies/dangers and concerns to the Health and Safety/Child Protection Officer (the headteacher) immediately. A copy of both policies are available at the school.

IECHYD A DIOGELWCH / HEALTH AND SAFETY

Mae'r adeilad yn un ar ddeg mlwydd oed erbyn hyn ac yn parhau i fod mewn cyflwr da ac yn darparu cyfleusterau o safon uchel ar gyfer ei ddisgyblion. Caiff yr adeilad ei gadw a'i gynnal dan arweiniad Cyngor Sir Gaerfyrddin a'r gwasanaeth glanhau. Mae cyfleusterau, megis toiledau yn cael eu cadw'n lân gan y ddau lanheuwyr ac maent yn ddigonol ar gyfer y nifer o blant yn yr ysgol.

The building is now eleven years old and continues to be in a good state, providing excellent and modern facilities for its pupils and staff. The school is maintained and kept well under the service level agreement between the school and Carmarthenshire County Council. The toilets are kept clean and hygienic by the two cleaners and these facilities conform with the Welsh Government guidelines.



Yn dilyn blwyddyn brysur arall, mae'r holl staff i'w canmol am safon y ddarpariaeth a gynigir i ddisgyblion Peniel. Gweithia pob un yn gydwybodol er mwyn sicrhau'r gorau ar gyfer yr holl ddisgyblion. Traciwn gynnydd disgyblion trwy gynnal cyfarfodydd cynnydd tymhorol yn ogystal â defnyddio system Taith360, asesir cynnydd plentyn ymhob rhan o'i waith ac, os oes angen, cysylltir â rhieni.

Ein nod fel ysgol yw addysgu plant i'w llawn botensial mewn awyrgylch hapus, diogel a chartrefol. Mae'n angenrheidiol i blant gael eu haddysgu a'u datblygu'n emosiynol, cymdeithasol, corfforol moesol a deallusol.

Y mae gan yr ysgol hefyd bolisi cydraddoldeb. Ceisir hyrwyddo'r polisi trwy ei gynnwys yn y cwricwlwm a'r gwersi a addysgir pan fydd cyfle. It also considers national and local priorities and an analysis of the end of stage results data. The targets are appraised regularly.

- Strengthen opportunities for pupils to make independent choices about how they learn

All the staff are to be commended for the quality of provision offered to the pupils of Peniel again this last academic year. All work conscientiously to ensure the best education for all our pupils. We track pupils' by conducting termly pupil's progress meeting and using Taith 360. Every child's progress is continually assessed over every aspect of their work, and, if necessary, the parents contacted.

Our aim as a school is to educate children to their full potential in a happy, safe, homely/comfortable environment. It is vital that children be educated and developed emotionally, socially, physically, morally and intellectually.

The school has an equal opportunities policy. An effort is made to promote this policy by including it in the curriculum and at every opportunity during the lessons taught. Following the 1998 Education Act and recent changes to the national curriculum, the school produces and revises its policies to clarify how it meets the stated requirements.

By using a teaching and learning method which is based on themes, our curriculum ensures that every child is fully enrolled as a valuable member of our school community. We ensure a broad, balanced, relevant and differentiated curriculum to all.


